Sub: - **Notice for General Strike on 2nd September, 2015 – req.**

In accordance with the provisions of sub para (1) of section 22 of the Industrial Disputes Act, 1947, it is hereby notified that the BSNL employees will go on General Strike on 2nd September, 2015.

Demands: (part A)

- 1) Urgent measures for containing price-rise through universalisation of public distribution system and banning speculative trade in commodity market.
- 2) Containing unemployment through concrete measures for employment generation.
- 3) Strict enforcement of all basic labour laws without any exception or exemption and stringent punitive measures for violation of labour laws.
- 4) Universal social security cover for all workers.
- 5) Minimum wages of not less than Rs.15,000/- per month with provision of indexation.
- 6) Assured enhanced pension not less than Rs.3,000/- p.m. for the entire working population.
- 7) Stoppage of disinvestment in Central/State PSUs.
- 8) Stoppage of contractorisation in permanent perennial work and payment of same wage and benefits for contract workers as regular workers for same and similar work.
- 9) Removal of all ceilings on payment and eligible of bonus, provident fund, increase the quantum of gratuity.
- 10) Compulsory registration of trade unions within a period of 45 days from the date of submitting application; and immediate ratification of ILO Conventions C 87 and C 98.

- 11) Against Labour Law Amendments.
- 12) Against FDI in Railways, Insurance and Defence.

Demands: (part B)

- (i) No back door privatisation / disinvestment in BSNL.
- (ii) Drop the decision to form Subsidiary Tower Company.
- (iii) Financial help to BSNL for procurement of equipments.
- (iv) No merger of BSNL & MTNL. Merge BBNL with BSNL.
- (v) Do not implement the retrograde recommendations of the Deloittee Committee on HR issues.
- (vi) No VRS in BSNL.
- (vii) Immediate refund of Rs.4,700/- crore BWA spectrum charges.
- (viii) Transfer of all assets to BSNL.
- (ix) Payment of minimum PLI, even if BSNL does not earn profit.
- (x) 30% superannuation benefits to Directly Recruited employees.
